## How Does Enclosed Auto Transport Work?

The process isn't too complicated, especially with the right logistics company. Typically, you can receive a call from the transport company between 12 to 24 hours before your scheduled pickup. The driver will look over the vehicle before it's loaded onto the trailer to assess the condition by completing a checklist and noting any flaws on the vehicle. Once they reach the drop off point, they will inspect your vehicle again.

## Make Your Arrangement for Enclosed Auto Transport in Advance

## Remove All Personal Items From Vehicle

Enclosed auto transport isn't licensed to move personal items, and other goods. You should remove all your personal items from the vehicle. The only other items that we recommend you leave are aftermarket parts that are installed on the vehicle.
